VISUAL FIELD TESTING - WHAT EVERY TECHNICIAN SHOULD KNOW

Understanding visual field testing is essential in the eye clinic. This course will review various common pitfalls to avoid for more reliable results for your physician. Methods of visual field testing, key terminology and common defects seen in visual field testing will also be reviewed. The course will focus on key components to ensure the visual field is ready for the physician to review.

EVALUATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THYROID EYE DISEASE

This course will focus on the evaluation of thyroid eye disease, the most common autoimmune orbital disorder that is frequently misdiagnosed due to heterogeneous clinical presentation. Various treatment modalities including supportive measures, corticosteroids and radiation will be discussed as well as advances in monoclonal antibodies treatment.

MASTER MYSTERY: GLAUCOMA CASE INVESTIGATIONS

OPHTHALMIC PHOTOGRAPHY TIPS AND PEARLS

This course will provide an overview of fundus photography, the equipment used and the steps many people miss, keeping them from experiencing success behind the camera. Topics covered will include directing your patient for successful imaging, focus, exposure and the different parameters doctors expect to be followed for each type of imagery recorded.

STANDARDIZED ECHOGRAPHY

This course will include a presentation of the diagnosis and differential diagnosis of intraocular and orbital diseases with standardized echography, an advanced method of diagnostic ophthalmic ultrasound. This course is a review of the clinical applications of standardized echography in diagnosing diseases of the eye, orbit, and periorbital region. A systematic review of diseases which can be diagnosed with ultrasonography will be given. This course will specifically deal with the standardized A-scan and B-scan techniques, as used in ophthalmic diagnosis.
