MORNING PROGRAM	8:00-9:00 a.m.	CODING FUNDAMENTALS FOR THE OPHTHALMIC TECHNICIAN <i>Joy Woodke, COE, OCS, OCSR</i> This course will provide an overview of the key principles in ophthalmic coding and reimbursement. Modifier definitions and usage, surgical global periods, and correct coding initiative (CCI) bundles will be explored. The impact of the unique payer policies for Medicare and commercial payers will be identified and the role of the technician emphasized.
	9:00-9:30 a.m.	IS NORMAL TENSION GLAUCOMA THE DIAGNOSIS? <i>James Tsai, MD, MBA, FACS</i> This course reviews diagnostic strategies for normal tension glaucoma, a common entity with an extensive differential diagnosis. The course also discusses factors other than intraocular pressure that may be responsible for the progressive optic disc cupping and visual field loss seen in the disease. Several case discussions are presented to highlight the differential diagnosis of normal tension glaucoma.
	9:30-10:00 a.m.	UNDERSTANDING VISUAL FIELD TESTING <i>Craig Simms, BSc, COMT, CDOS, ROUB</i> This course will discuss the differences between kinetic and static visual field testing and principles for reliable testing. The course will then discuss automated testing strategies available for testing. The course will round out with discussing the visual field printout from automated perimeters.
